

What kind of people take the NEBOSH International General Certificate?

People throughout the world take the NEBOSH International General Certificate because it gives them the skills and know-how to fulfil their health and safety responsibilities in any country and in any kind of organisation.

What will I gain from this qualification?

Knowledge – Whether health and safety is your main responsibility, or just a part of what you do, the NEBOSH International General Certificate will give you vital knowledge to help you perform better in your role at work.

Enjoyment – You'll enjoy taking the NEBOSH International General Certificate. You'll discover skills and techniques that are useful and practical, not just theoretical.

Recognition – Holders of the NEBOSH International General Certificate in Occupational Health and Safety are entitled to Associate Membership (AIOSH) of the Institution of Occupational Safety and Health (IOSH). The qualification also meets the academic requirements for Technical Membership (Tech IOSH) of IOSH.

Career development – For some, the NEBOSH International General Certificate is a first step towards a life-long career in health and safety. For others, it forms part of an important set of qualifications that brings them success and advancement in whatever field they choose.

What will my employer gain from this qualification?

Are you already one step closer towards your next NEBOSH Certificate?

Management of International health and safety unit (IGC1) is common to the following qualifications:

- NEBOSH International General Certificate
- NEBOSH International Construction Certificate
- NEBOSH International Fire Certificate

If you study another qualification listed within 5 years of passing this unit, you will not need to re-sit it.

Once you have achieved the NEBOSH International General Certificate, you are only one unit away from achieving the NEBOSH National General Certificate too. Controlling Workplace Hazards (GC2) and the Practical Application (GC3) units are now common to both qualifications so you would only need to pass the Management of Health and Safety Unit (NGC1) to secure the NEBOSH National General Certificate.

Where can I take a course leading to the NEBOSH International General Certificate?

Details of training providers that represent NEBOSH throughout the world are on our website. These training providers offer courses to fit around your requirements:

- Distance or blended learning
- Day or evening courses over a number of weeks
- Block release or modular courses
- E-Learning

Sometimes courses can be arranged to take place where you work. Employers can also become accredited NEBOSH course providers so that they can provide in-house training for staff.
